**Lohri Celebration:** The Josephite family rejoiced around bonfire while singing traditional songs. Everyone came together to mark this harvest festival.

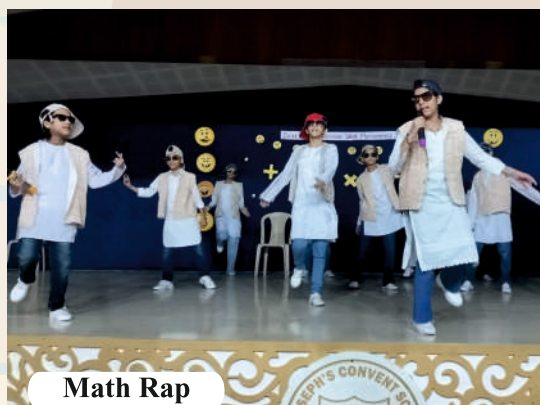

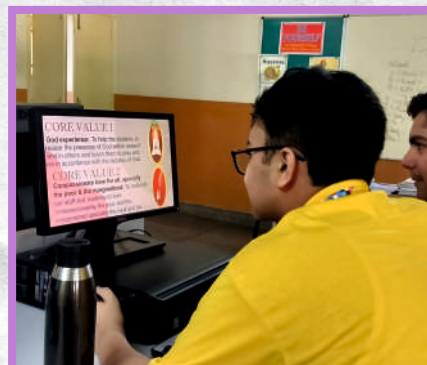

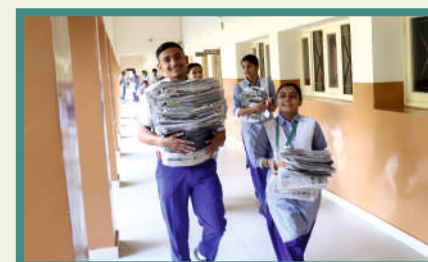

A seminar was conducted on mental health of adolescents by Jasleen Kaur, RCI recognised Clinical Psychologist. She motivated the students to stay away from drugs.

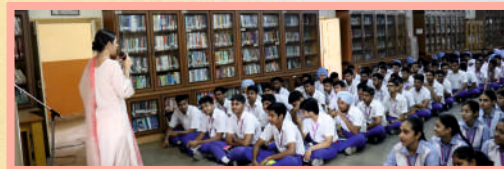
An informative lecture on unhealthy eating habits and sedentary lifestyle was conducted by District Health Officer, Dr Usha Goyal.

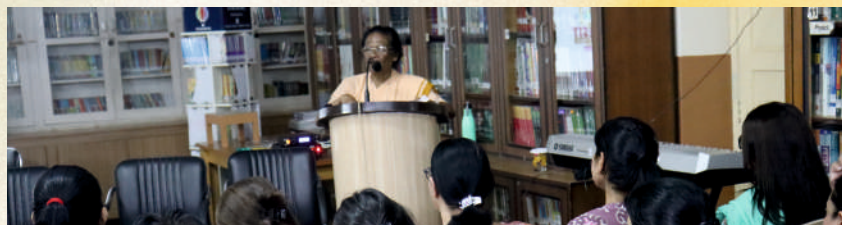
Orientation programme on stress management and importance of time management were conducted by the school alumni, Tanvi Singal and Niti Garg respectively.
