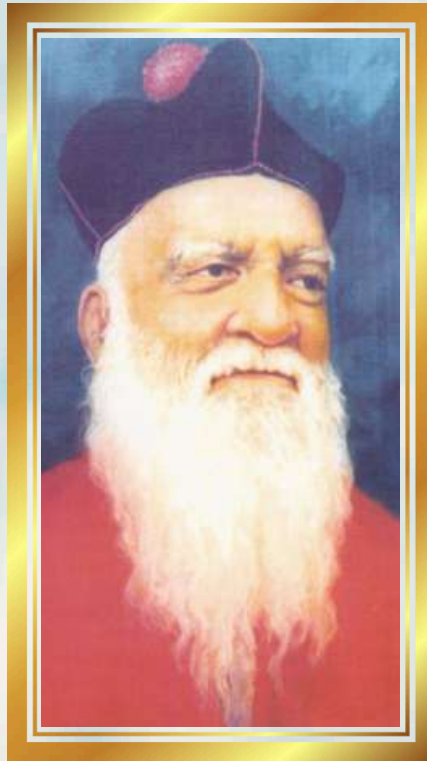

EDITOR'S MESSAGE

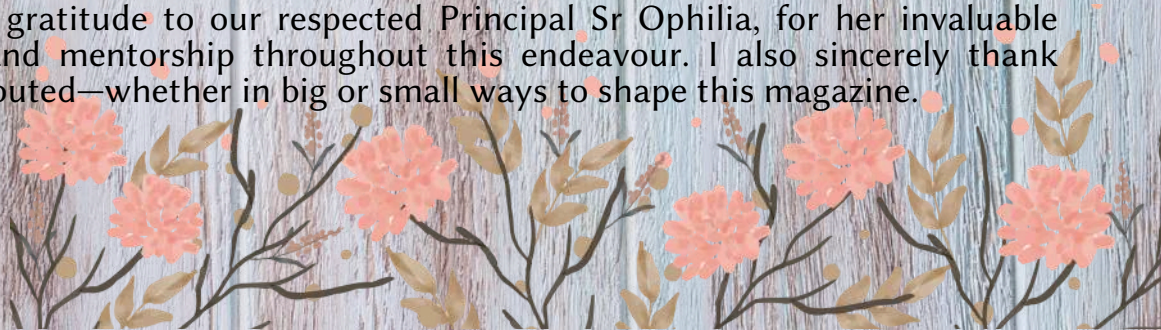
Dear Readers

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
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CORE VALUES

INDEPENDENCE DAY

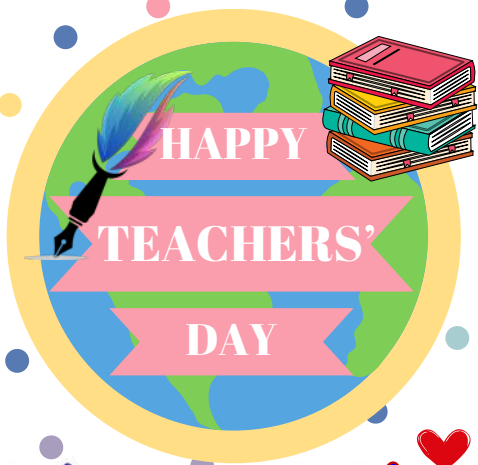
